



**SAFEND DATA PROTECTION SUITE (DPS)
MANAGEMENT SERVER & CONSOLE PATCH
UPDATER**

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General Information

In this document we will describe the Patch Updater functionality.

Server or Console patch are provided inside Safend signed self-contained package, it contains **Server.zip**, **Console.zip** and **manifest.id**.

Updater.exe requires to be run with elevated permissions.

It can run from a network share or locally on the server, it is recommended to run the **Updater.exe** from command line.

Once the **Updater.exe** is running, it is verifying the Safend installed version matches to the **Updater.exe** version, if the version doesn't match, execution will be stopped without any change to the system.

Once verification is completed, Safend services will be turned off, backups will be created:

\Program Files\Safend\Safend Data Protection\bin_YYYYMMDD_HHMM

\Program Files\Safend\Safend Data Protection\consoleUpdater\console_YYYYMMDD_HHMM

\Program Files\Safend\Safend Data Protection\consoleUpdater\manifests_YYYYMMDD_HHMM

Note: Backups will not be removed unless deleted manually, including after uninstall process.

Once the update is completed, services will be turned on again.

Run Patch Updater

1. Download **Updater.exe**
2. Login into the Server the Safend Management Server is installed on
3. Run **Updater.exe**

Rollback

To roll back to the previous version:

1. Stop the **Safend services**
 - a. **Safend Data Protection Local Service**
 - b. **World Wide Web Publishing Service**
 - c. **Safend Data Protection DB** - Depends on existence
2. Rename the "**bin**" folder to be "**bin_old**" *\Program Files\Safend\Safend Data Protection\bin*
3. Rename the relevant "**bin_YYYYMMDD_HHMM**" backup folder to "**bin**"
4. Rename the "**Console.zip**" file to be "**Console.zip_old**" *\Program Files\Safend\Safend Data Protection\consoleUpdater\console.zip*
5. Rename the relevant "**Console_YYYYMMDD_HHMM.zip**" backup file to "**Console.zip**"
6. Rename the "**manifests.xml**" file to be "**manifests.xml_old**" *\Program Files\Safend\Safend Data Protection\consoleUpdater\manifest.xml*
7. Rename the relevant "**manifest_YYYYMMDD_HHMM.xml**" backup file to "**manifests.xml**"
8. Start the **Safend services**
 - a. **Safend Data Protection Local Service**



- b. **World Wide Web Publishing Service**
- c. ***Safend Data Protection DB*** – Depends on existence
